Purpose

The “Throw & Go Contest” is a contest created by the Community Associates of the Black Belt Community Foundation to support its Community Grants Program.

Contest Prize

A donor has given to the Black Belt Community Foundation a pair of tickets to the **2022 IRON BOWL** (Alabama vs. Auburn Football Game) to be played at Bryant-Denny Stadium in Tuscaloosa, AL on Saturday, November 26, 2022.

CONTEST RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Tickets will be mailed, delivered or picked-up by the county coordinator or a designated community associate from each county. The county coordinator or community associates will pass the tickets on to each community associate. The tickets will be numbered for accountability purposes.
2. Tickets are available for purchase from BBCF Board members, county coordinators, community associates, BBCF staff members and/or online at www.blackbeltfound.org or via Eventbrite (bit.ly/bbcfthrowandgo2022) .
3. Potential donors will be asked to give a \$5.00 donation for each ticket. The seller of the tickets are encouraged to collect the donors full name, phone number, email and mailing address of the purchaser. This will increase the BBCF donor database.
4. Individuals who purchase at least \$20 in tickets will be given 1 bonus ticket.
5. Individuals who purchase \$50 in tickets will be given 5 bonus tickets.

6. Individuals who purchase \$100 in tickets will be given 10 bonus tickets.
7. Each county coordinator and community associate will sell as many tickets as he/she can from receipt of the tickets until Friday, November 4, 2022. All tickets and funds will be turned in to the BBCF Headquarters by noon on Monday, November 7, 2022. Online tickets can be purchase through the Eventbrite link until 11:30 pm on Monday, November 14th.
8. All tickets sold will be placed into a container, and a BBCF Board member will randomly pull one ticket from the container on Tuesday, November 15, 2022. The name that is pulled will be the individual selected to participate in the Black Belt Community Foundation "Throw & Go Contest".
9. The drawing will be captured by video for transparency.
10. The BBCF Chief Community Engagement Officer or BBCF President will contact the contestant on November 15th immediately following the drawing. The Community Engagement Officer will schedule the "Throw and Go Skills Contest" prior to the date of the 2022 IRON BOWL.
11. The contestant will have 3 tries to complete a 12-yard pass to a BBCF Staff Member. The 12 yards are symbolic of the number of counties that are in the Black Belt Community Foundation's service area.
12. Again, the skills contest will be captured by video for transparency and documentation of the integrity of the contest.
13. The President of the BBCF will present the prize to the winner.
14. BBCF will reserve the rights to share any videos related to the contest online, through social media and with the media as needed.
15. All Alabama state laws will be followed in the execution of the Black Belt Community Foundation "Throw & Go Contest". All questions and concerns should be directed to Christopher H.
